Elsie worked with MPI for three years and was an alumna of MPI's Annual Peacebuilding Training. She was a model peacebuilder in a simple but profound way. She internalized the values of a peacebuilder—a culture of peace, love, and respect for life—and lived these to the fullest. To honor Elsie as a person and peacebuilder, MPI established the Elsie M. Bacayo Annual Peacebuilding Training Scholarship Fund to enable deserving peacebuilders to participate in MPI's Annual Peacebuilding Training.

1. The Elsie Bacayo Scholarships are available to help with the course fees for MPI's Annual Peacebuilding Training only. Participants or their organization will be responsible for all flight/visa/travel costs to Davao City, Philippines.
2. The scholarship is limited to fees for one course during the Annual Peacebuilding Training. If you plan to take more than one course, you, your sending organization, or a sponsoring organization must cover the fees for the additional course(s).

3. Demonstrates clear support and connection to an organization or institution working in the field of peacebuilding, development and/or human rights.
